



AUTO ELITE CUSTOMS (grades 7-12)

During this enrichment class students will get a glimpse at what it takes to run a shop. Students will learn how to document customer vehicles, how to order parts from our distributors, make repairs and modifications to customer vehicles and finally write invoice to return vehicle to customer. Students will get a chance to learn about custom paints and various ways of customizing a car at low cost. This enrichment class aims to teach students how they can make extra money doing small custom projects at home.

COSMETOLOGY The Art of Looking Great! (Grades 3-12)

Caring for your hair and nails is the beginning of looking great. Students will learn and practice creating a look that flatters their personal style. Hair styling, cutting and coloring will be discussed and demonstrated. Students will learn skills that will save money at the nail salon including manicures, pedicures and nail art.



MULTIMEDIA AND TV PRODUCTION (Grades 3-6 & Grades 7-12)

Multimedia production utilizes an all-digital lab to teach students of all skill levels. Students will have the opportunity to learn about graphic design, video and audio production and music programs. They will then bring their ideas to life in TV production. Students learn how to master the camera, using state-of-the-art equipment, teamwork, imagination, and creativity to create their films. Students will produce their own commercials, music videos, short movies, studio shows and more. This class will be challenging, fun, and cutting edge.

ANIMAL SCIENCE (Grades 4-8)

Students will work with our extensive animal collection that includes a miniature horse, goats, exotic birds, reptiles, rodents, ferrets, cats, dogs, etc. Emphasis is placed on proper care and grooming for these animals. Responsible handling and disease prevention will be stressed. Students will participate in animal enrichment, taming, and physical exams. Veterinary specialties and animal careers will be discussed. Students will have the opportunity to bring in their well-mannered pet for help with grooming or training. The specific animals studied will be tailored to the interests of the students.



Computer Keyboarding (Grades 5-12)

Learn basic keyboarding skills in this introductory course. This is one of the most important skills you can learn. Emphasis is placed on learning the keyboard using the touch system. This course will also help to build keyboarding speed and accuracy.
