

# **Getting Started with Your Applications**

Applying to college can feel overwhelming, but breaking it down into manageable steps can make the process much smoother. Here's a document to guide you through the initial stages of your college applications, focusing on how to use Common App and SchooLinks together effectively.

# **Step 1: Common App Setup - Your College Apps**

The Common App is a platform used by hundreds of colleges. Here's how to get started:

#### 1. Start Your Common App Account:

Visit the <u>Common App website</u> and create an account.

#### 2. Add Arlington Career Center as Your School:

• In the Education section, add Arlington Career Center as your school. Make sure you select the correct high school!

#### 1. Add Colleges & Sign the FERPA:

- Add colleges you're applying to in the "My Colleges" tab.
- Crucially, sign the FERPA (Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act) waiver for one of the colleges you add - this will apply to all colleges in your list. This allows your counselor to send your transcripts and recommendations.
- THIS VIDEO will show you how to access and sign the FERPA in your Common App account

## **Step 2: SchooLinks Access and Setup**

**SchooLinks** is the platform we use to send transcripts and recommendations to colleges.

Here's how to set it up:

#### 1. Access SchooLinks via MyAccess:

• Log into MyAccess, and find the SchooLinks link to access the platform.

#### 2. Complete Onboarding (If Needed):

o If this is your first time using SchooLinks, follow the on boarding steps.

#### 3. College Application Manager Setup:

- Follow the prompts to set up your College Application Manager.
- This involves adding your home and email address, indicating your eligibility for application fee waivers, and signing the FERPA waiver *again*. It's essential to sign the FERPA on *both* Common App *and* SchooLinks.

# **Step 3: Connecting Common App and SchooLinks**

Now, you need to connect your **Common App** account to your **SchooLinks** account. Once connected, you will be able to request transcripts, recommendations, or other documents through your **SchooLinks** platform.

Follow these instructions for connecting your accounts

Important Note: All document requests (transcripts, recommendations) must be submitted through SchooLinks, *not* through the Common App.
